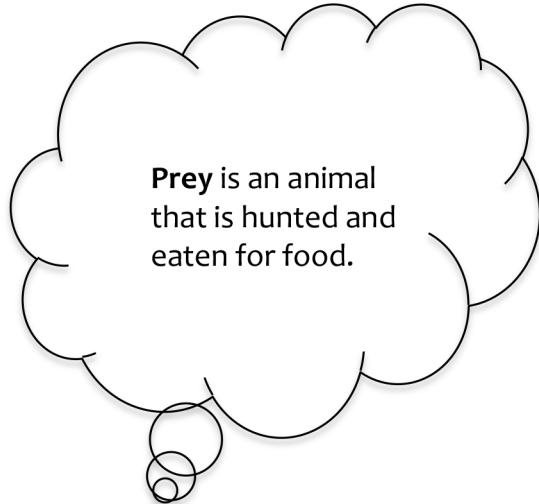
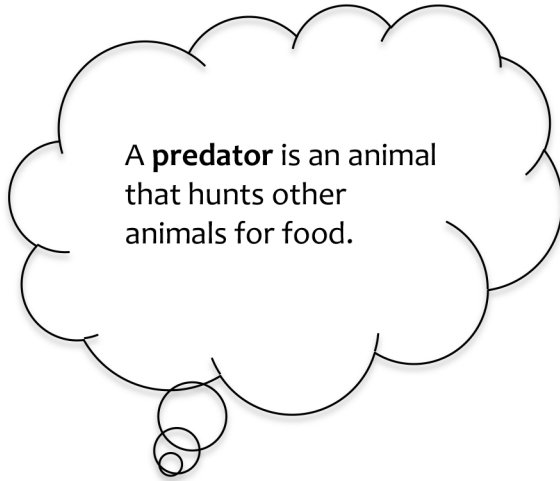


Predator and Prey
